<mark>John 1:1-3</mark>

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."

2 "He was in the beginning with God."

3 "All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made."

Often when we think of Jesus, we think (Slide)

- The Son of God
- Our Healer
- Our Redeemer
- Our Savior!!
- And He is all of that!!!
- There is no other name by which a man can be saved...

Jesus is all of that...And MORE!!! (SLIDE)

He is The Word:

Greek: Logos (SLIDE)

Strongs definition for this usage:

In John, denotes the essential Word of God, Jesus Christ, the personal wisdom and power in union with God, his minister in creation and government of the universe, the cause of all the world's life both physical and ethical, which for the procurement of man's salvation put on human nature in the person of Jesus the Messiah, the second person in the Godhead, and shone forth conspicuously from His words and deeds. We don't tend to think much about Jesus in terms of Creator...

• That's God the Father...

But understand... Before Jesus was born in flesh on this Earth as The Son...

- He has always been here as The Word....
- He was there in the beginning...
- With God
- Because He is God
- An equal member of the Godhead

So today, I want to leave you with this thought...

- Yes, when He was on The Cross, we were on HIs mind...
- But we were on His mind long before that...
- He was thinking about us in Creation...
- He was thinking about us when this earth was designed
- He put those stars in the sky and designed the beauty of the sunset
- He made us who we are
